



# YOUR PET ROAD TRIP CHECKLIST

- Determine your stopping points before hitting the road.**  
While travelling with your dog or cat, both of you will need bathroom breaks. Map out stops accordingly and make sure each location has an area for pets.
- Consider purchasing car safety equipment.**
